



The Big Help Project mission is to feed the hungry, help communities overcome poverty and assist people onto a better future. Originating in Knowsley, we provide emergency food and food clubs, money & welfare advice, housing support, recycled paint, employability, and many more services across Merseyside and the UK.

Our Food Clubs provide an alternative to foodbanks and offer better access to affordable essentials, as well as the dignity to select the food and provisions you want. These clubs provide members with inexpensive groceries

and household items, offering surplus goods from retailers and wholesalers. These products are often donated because of over production, mislabelling or minor damaged packaging meaning the food is still fit for consumption. By offering this stock through our Food Clubs, we have saved over 260 tonnes worth of food from going to landfill in 2022 - and this year we are on course to double that figure!

It's not just our Food Clubs that help reduce waste - we're trying to reduce the impact of fast fashion too! We encourage people to donate their unwanted clothes, books, small electrical items, furniture, and various other goods to our community shops. Through our shops we offer these pre-loved items at affordable prices, perfect for those on a budget and those hunting for a bargain. Who knows what you might find amongst the shelves!

Our 'Painting Green' project has been running for over 7 years and ticks all the boxes for sustainability. We collect and distribute over 50,000 litres of recycled paint each year which has led to us creating our own brand of recycled paint 'dECOrate'. This is sold at an affordable price to local families and individuals, and it is also donated to community groups to help brighten spaces across our region.

Further developments towards sustainability and our Net Zero target include the use of electric vehicles and bikes within our fleet, electric charge points at several of our offices and warehouses, and the installation of solar panels to generate our own energy at our main offices.


Big Help Project believes in helping the community on all fronts, and that includes preserving the natural environment. We're very proud to be part of the Knowsley Flower Show for another year.
